

In knitting, there are only two stitches: knit and purl. Everything else is just a combination or manipulation of these two stitches. Here is the knit stitch.

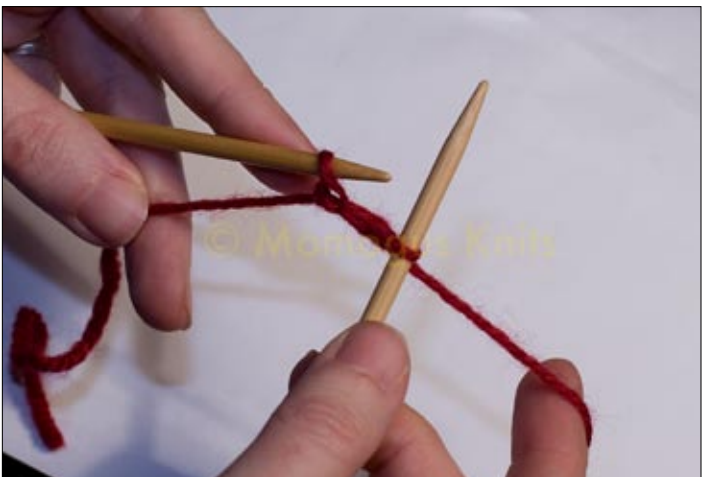

1. Insert Right Hand Needle (RHN) into the stitch on the LHN from front to back:
3. Bring the yarn through by pushing with the RHN:



2. Bring yarn (the strand going back to the ball) around the back of the RHN:
4. Now slide stitch off the LHN onto the RHN:
