

## The Purl Stitch

The Purl Stitch is essentially the knit stitch in reverse. Your yarn will be in front of your needles, instead of behind as when you knit.


- 1. Insert Right Hand Needle (RHN) into the stitch on the Left Hand Needle (LHN) from back to front:
- 3. Bring the yarn through by pushing with the RHN





- 2. Bring yarn (the strand going back to the ball) around the back of the RHN:
- 4. Now slide stitch off the LHN onto the RHN
